Thought for the week

This coming Tuesday we are celebrating the Feast of Saints Peter and Paul which is a holy day of obligation. (You will find the times of Mass at our three churches elsewhere on this newsletter.) From the earliest times Christians from the world over have made pilgrimages to Rome to visit the tombs of the apostles Peter and Paul, in order to experience the Catholic nature of the Church as directly as possible. Catholic, as everyone knows, means universal. And universal means something that is for everyone. The message of Saints Peter and Paul was a message for all peoples and for all times. Their preaching, sealed in their blood by their martyrdom in Rome, contains something that speaks to human experience across the ages and across cultures. When one goes to Rome, even today, one sees people from all over the earth, all drawn by the same faith, in the same God, called into the one Church. So on this feast we celebrate our unity in faith, and our shared rootedness in the apostles, and we rejoice in being part of the one, holy, Catholic and Apostolic Church.
