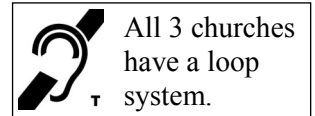

Initial Safeguarding Awareness Training at The Centre, Arundel Cathedral, BN18 9AY on Wednesday, 25th July 2018 from 7-9 p.m. This training session is for those who work with or minister to vulnerable groups (Children and Adults at Risk.) It is the expectation of the Bishop, Trustees and Safeguarding Commission that this initial training is undertaken and refreshed every three years. New volunteers should undertake the initial training within the first year of being appointed. A refresher training programme will take place in November starting with those who did their training in 2015. People are welcome to attend initial and refresher sessions in other Deaneries if this is more convenient. There will be one Initial Safeguarding Awareness session per Deanery per year and from September, one Refresher session per Deanery per year.
