After a number of enquiries I'm very pleased to tell you we now have someone who is both able and willing to carve a statue of St Richard: Rosemary Bradshaw, a friend of a parishioner who lives in Brighton. Our new statue which will complement the statues of Our Lady of Walsingham and St Joseph, will be placed in the Blessed Sacrament Chapel, against the wall on the right of the altar.

Our hope is that it will be ready in time for our patronal feast on 16th June next year. The reason for the delay is quite simply, "pressure of work". Mrs Bradshaw not only has a full-time job but she is also very involved in icons. I'm sure you agree a wood-carver with strong Christian faith is the ideal person to ensure a devotional work of art. Our sculptress is not only a practicing Catholic but she also belongs to the Third Order of Mount Carmel—a connection that will not be lost on our older parishioners.

The cost of the statue will be £5,000 and the fund is open. Every pound will help. Please place your donation in an envelope marked St Richard's statue.
