White Flower Appeal NEXT weekend

- The Society for the Protection of Unborn Children (SPUC) will be holding its annual appeal after all Masses on 19/20 January. SPUC works tirelessly to uphold the sanctity of human life from conception to natural death. Its work covers a wide spectrum of pro-life issues, including providing practical support to women in crisis pregnancies, offering Helpline counselling to people struggling with the impact of the loss of a child before birth, and helping parents protect their children from anti-life propaganda. SPUC is currently campaigning to oppose the removal of the present legal restraints on abortion, which, at the moment, provide at least some protection for mothers and unborn babies – 'decriminalising' abortion would pose many grave dangers, especially for the most vulnerable. Please give as generously as you can, to help SPUC protect all vulnerable life.
