With so many major events being cancelled or postponed, I was glad to learn that the Youth Festival in Medjugorje went ahead this year albeit with precautionary measures. Apart from the ongoing process of examining the authenticity of the apparitions. that place has become a spiritual hotspot for young people looking for a deep spiritual experience of prayer and sharing their faith. Over the years of my priestly ministry I have come across many people whose lives have been transformed by a visit to Medjugorje. This year Pope Francis addressed the attendees in a special message, praising the quality time they enjoyed – as it was time filled with prayer, reflection and fraternal meeting, "time that gives you the opportunity to meet the living Jesus Christ, in a special way in the celebration of the Holy Eucharist, in Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and in the Sacrament of Reconciliation."

"It thus helps you discover a different way of life," he continued, "different from the one offered by the culture of the temporary, according to which nothing can be permanent, the culture that knows only the pleasure of the present moment. In this atmosphere of relativism, in which it is difficult to find true and sure answers, the motto of the Festival: 'Come, and you shall see' (John 1:39), the words used by Jesus to address his disciples, are a blessing. Jesus is also looking at you, inviting you to come and stay with Him."

He concluded by pointing to a powerful companion on our journey of faith: "The great example of the Church that is young in the heart, ready to follow Christ with new freshness and fidelity, always remains the Virgin Mary," the pope said in the message, sent in Croatian and released by the Holy See press office on 2 August.

"The power of Her 'Yes' and Her 'Let it be unto me' which she said before the angel, delights us at all times. Her 'Yes' means participating and taking risks, without any guarantee except knowing that she is the bearer of the promise. Her 'Behold the handmaid of the Lord' (Luke 1:38), the most beautiful example that tells us what happens when someone, in their freedom, surrenders themself into God's hands."

"Let this example inspire you and be your guideline!"

### **Attending Public Masses**

## It is now a requirement by the Government for us all to wear masks to Mass (except, obviously, for all those who are exempt).

Although this is counter to everything we believe, we must ask you not to come along to a weekend Mass unless you have checked in advance that there are spaces for you. Weekend Masses are now all full until 30 August.
